# INTRODUCTION

Effective programs for pregnant and parenting teens offer an important service to New Mexico. First, they play a critical role in reducing our repeat teen pregnancy rate. Secondly, they ameliorate the negative consequences once a pregnancy has already occurred.

Research conducted on New Mexico programs for pregnant and parenting teens demonstrates the value of these interventions.<sup>1</sup>

- 4% of the young women became pregnant after enrollment and only 2% of those enrolled in the program for 12 months or more had a repeat pregnancy. This rate is vastly lower than other comparable national programs, and substantially lower than the national rate.
- 84% of those who had left school before being recruited into these programs returned to school. 77% increased their education or stayed in school in the same grade during the period of program enrollment, a rate well above those reported by other national programs.
- Only 5% of the young mothers had low birth weight babies, a rate that is lower than both the state and national rates.

This directory includes a compilation of all the known programs that serve New Mexico's pregnant and parenting teens. NMTPC would be pleased to add any additional programs upon receipt of the necessary information. The directory will be updated at least once a year and is available online at our website or as a hard copy.

We hope this will be a useful tool in helping you locate services for the pregnant and parenting teens in your community.
